Travel Plans

If you apply and are accepted to the Adult RailCamp Program, we will need to know your travel plans. The NRHS staff will do everything to assist you to get to the RailCamp location. If you are accepted, we will contact you for specific information about your travel plans. It is your responsibility to get to Ely, NV for the RailCamp.

Payments

To apply for Adult RailCamp, you must submit the completed application along with a check for \$750 if paid before April 1, or \$850 if paid after April 1, 2007 for the June session or \$750 by August 1, or \$850 after August 1 for the September session. Tuition rate assumes double occupancy in rooms. Single occupancy is available for an additional fee; please make sure you have checked the single room option above. Make checks payable to the National Railway Historical Society. Return the application to: Adult RailCamp 2008, National Railway Historical Society, 100 N. 17th St., Suite 1203, Philadelphia, PA 19103-2783. You can pay the RailCamp tuition by credit card by calling 215-557-6606 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on weekdays.

The NRHS requires that all Adult RailCamps be self sufficient. Each camp requires a minimum enrollment of eight individuals. If the enrollment does not reach eight by 30 days prior to the scheduled start of the session, the program will be cancelled and you will be informed.

Please note. *It is your responsibility to arrange your own transportation to and from the RailCamp location. In the event of an unforeseen schedule change for Adult RailCamp, the National Railway Historical Society will incur no financial liability where you have secured non-refundable transportation.*
